Dogs in Garden Rules

- Dogs must remain on a lead at all times.
- It is the member's responsibility to ensure the behavior of their dog.
- Dogs must remain in the benched area of the garden.
- Dogs are not allowed in the river.
- Dogs are not allowed on the piece of the garden adjacent to the white house in the corner of the garden.
- Dogs are not allowed in the smoking area or car park.
- Whilst dogs naturally barked, members are to ensure this is not continuous.
- It is the member's responsibility to ensure the welfare of their dog and to ensure freshwater bowls are available at all times.
- It is the member's responsibility to not allow their dog to be in direct sunlight for an excessive amount of time.
- Dogs are not allowed in the clubhouse, no exceptions (guide dogs exempt)
- Dogs must be removed from club grounds before 9.30 pm.
- There may be times when the committee decides it is unsuitable or safe for dogs to be in the garden, notice will be given in such circumstances and must be adhered to.
- No dogs to be left unattended in the garden at any time. except when purchasing drinks or using facilities. (dogs must be secured)

It is the member's responsibility to clean up after their dog, taking any waste home with them. the club does not have the facility to dispose of dog waste.
